**Hours:** 6:30 AM—6:00 PM (excluding school hours)

**Opportunities:** Cooperative games, snacks, sports, table games, music time, reading, homework, arts & crafts, clubs.

**Staff:** All staff members are drug tested, have background checks, are first aid certified, and meet training requirements each year. There is at least one CPR certified staff member present at each site. AYS maintains a staff to child ratio of 1:12 to 1:15.

**Days of Operation:** AYS is open on all regular school days. AYS is *closed* Labor Day, Memorial Day, Thanksgiving Break, Christmas Day, New Year’s Day, President’s Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, and the last Friday before summer break begins. Winter, Spring, and Summer break locations to be announced. Morning programs run with a minimum of 10 children daily.

Weekly fees include extended service due to early dismissals, morning delays, and full-day school closures due to snow or other emergencies. For three-day or less part-time participants, if a closure or delay occurs on a day that the child is regularly scheduled to attend, that extended service is included in regular fees. In case of severe weather or emergencies in which AYS is not able to operate, full weekly fees are still due.

**Breaks and Summer:** AYS operates full-day sites during fall, Thanksgiving, winter, spring and summer breaks. AYS reserves the right to close sites over breaks due to low enrollment. A different fee applies to breaks. Programming for breaks may be held at a different location. Information will be available in advance.

**Snacks and Drinks:** Juice or milk and a nutritious snack will be served each morning and afternoon. On days that school is not in session, but AYS may be open, each child must bring a sack lunch. AYS participates in the Child and Adult Care Food Program. There will be no discrimination in the course of snack service.

**Each child must be registered each year** in order to attend AYS. The child is **NOT** considered registered until payment is received.

**Registration Fee (NON-REFUNDABLE) - Register Early! Programs have limited capacity.**

\$20 per child by June 30 / \$30 per child after July 1 if space is still available.

**The Flex Pass** will be available for purchase starting July 1, 2016.

**Financial assistance** may be available and is based on the government funding guidelines. **Any Family currently receiving or seeking financial assistance must register at the AYS administrative office. CCDF Vouchers accepted.** Call 317-283-3817 for more information.
