2022-2023 HIGHLIGHTS

With COVID-19's restrictions lifted, we focused on creating high-engagement experiences that extend school day learning to boost children's academic success and social and emotional well-being.

- We prioritized integrating and adopting a Diversity, Equity, Inclusion, and Accessibility (DEIA) lens for every aspect of our practices and formed a council to oversee and implement best practices.
- We worked to ensure all families could have access to our services regardless of socioeconomic status, so we leverage private and public funding streams with additional in-kind partner support.
- Through quarterly surveying and regular check-ins with school partners, AYS programs proved to boost academic performance and positive behavior while creating a sense of belonging among students.
- Day in and day out, we provided parents peace of mind knowing their children were in a safe, enriching space getting the most out of critical out-of-school hours.

Each step was made possible by the support of our staff, our Board of Directors, and you, our stakeholders. 




A Culture of Belonging







In FY23, AYS made the transformative decision to move all Youth Development Leaders to a year-round salaried position with a minimum of 3 weeks paid vacation, full cafe health plans, retirement contributions and professional development program. A year in, and the return on investment has been exceptional in terms of employee engagement and retention. This will have a tremendous impact on administrative efficiency, program quality, and relationship building with the children, school faculty, and communities we serve.



Financial performance for this fiscal year was consistent with the previous year. This demonstrates that AYS is effectively managing its resources and is steadily gaining momentum lost due to the market landscape over the last few years. AYS and many other non-profits are facing a sharp decrease in public funding to support programming and operations. AYS is currently heavily reliant on parent fees, public funding, and grants from private institutions. Opportunities exist in expanding other revenue streams by adding new services in keeping with its mission, leveraging partnerships to decrease expenses, and increasing individual private donations as well as corporate donations. These initiatives are key components of AYS's three-year strategic plan (July 2024 - June 2026) to diversify revenue streams and continue to build long-term sustainability.
