WHY: This summer, IPS deepened their partnership with AYS to provide full wrap-around summer enrichment for the school district's students placed academically at-risk. For the first time in our history together, IPS and AYS operated in tandem to provide summer school and full-service summer camp for free to school sites in the north, south, east, and west - for traditionally underserved students/families who don't often have school-based enrichment beyond the classroom/school year. Together, we served over 500 students - and our Winter in July celebration is a way for students to cool off after an academically full, engaging summer.
